The 1st annual North Carolina CORNHOLE Championship Tournament will be limited to one hundred (100) teams. Applications will be accepted on first received basis. Entry fee for the tournament is \$50.00 per team if received or Pay Pal confirmed on or before April 15, 2010. After that date the entry fee will be \$75.00 per team.

TOURNAMENT: The tournament will use a 2 person team, double elimination format. The tournament will begin Friday, April 30, 2010 at 5 PM and recess at 10 PM and resume at 10 AM, Saturday, May 1, 2010. Pairings will be determined by a hat draw.

PRACTICE: Practice time will be Friday, April 30, 2010 from 9 AM to 4 PM. There will be 30 minute limits on a practice session.

AWARDS: Final cash awards and number of places will be determined by total number of team entries. Trophies will be awarded to the Champion and the Runner up.

RULES: Rules of the American Cornhole Association will apply.

Unless otherwise stated, decisions by the Hog Fest in Historic Edenton Cornhole Tournament Chairperson are final.
