- Only one item per lot number can be entered by each exhibitor.
- Items exhibited in this division must be the work of the exhibitor whose name appears on the entry tag.
- Items will be accepted and displayed at the superintendent's discretion.
- No commercial mixes may be used unless altered. Only 1/2 a cake or pie has to be entered.
- Refrigeration **IS NOT** available. No refrigerated items will be accepted.
- When judging decorated cakes the judging will be on decorations only.
- Items **MUST BE** on a plate **AND** covered or in a bag. Please use disposable plates for entries. Fair is not responsible for returning plates, lids, containers, etc.
- **The recipe used MUST be included with each entry.**
- Judges shall not award premiums to any exhibit deemed unworthy. The option is reserved to withhold ribbons and awards in lots where there is no deserving entry.
- Where there is no competition, or an exhibit has been incorrectly entered, judges may award first, second or third premiums or no premium, according to the merits of the exhibit.
- "Any Other" and "Any not listed" are the same as "Any Other Not Listed."
- "**PROFESSIONAL**" – refers to anyone who is paid to teach baking/cooking, or sells baked goods and products that they make.
- Entries must be picked up the **SUNDAY** immediately following the Fair between the hours of **11 am - 3 pm**. The FAIR IS NOT RESPONSIBLE for any item not picked up on Sunday immediately following the Fair.
